

The following is what you will need to provide for a potential SCCA license waiver.

Copy of your current membership card.

1. If you do not have a current membership, complete the application you received or download from <http://www.scca.com/documents/membership/sccamemberapp.pdf> with the appropriate fees for National and your Region made out to SCCA.
2. Completed license application with the fee of \$90.00 for National license or \$80.00 for Regional license made out to SCCA. Form can be found at <http://www.scca.com/documents/Club%20Forms/form-license.pdf>
3. Completed current physical form found at <http://www.scca.com/documents/Club%20Forms/form-physicalexam.pdf>
4. A short resume of your racing experience along with documentation (results, letters/diplomas from SCCA accredited racing schools) types of cars raced, organizations, Novice Permit and type of car you are going to race.
5. What level of license you are applying for, National or Regional.
6. A separate check for \$25.00 made out to Great Lakes Division, SCCA for waiving processing fee.
7. Include an envelope addressed to SCCA Membership Services, P.O. Box 299 Topeka KS 66601-0299. Make sure it has appropriate postage as well.
8. Mail all this to: Bryan Floyd 12146 Eaglescout Ct, Cincinnati Oh 45249
9. Keep a copy for yourself just in case.

11. Give yourself plenty of time before your first event. There can be up to a two week turn around time depending on when I receive your letter.
